Values of Football



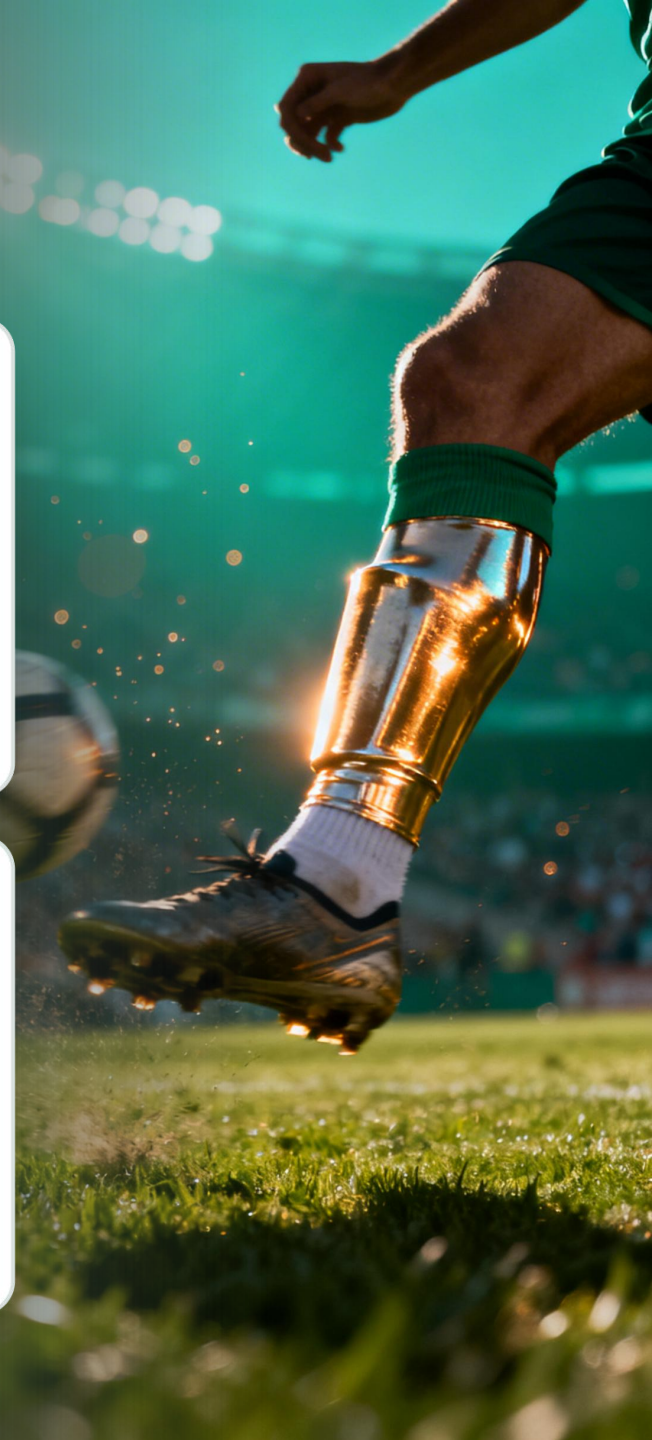
Physical and Mental Tests
