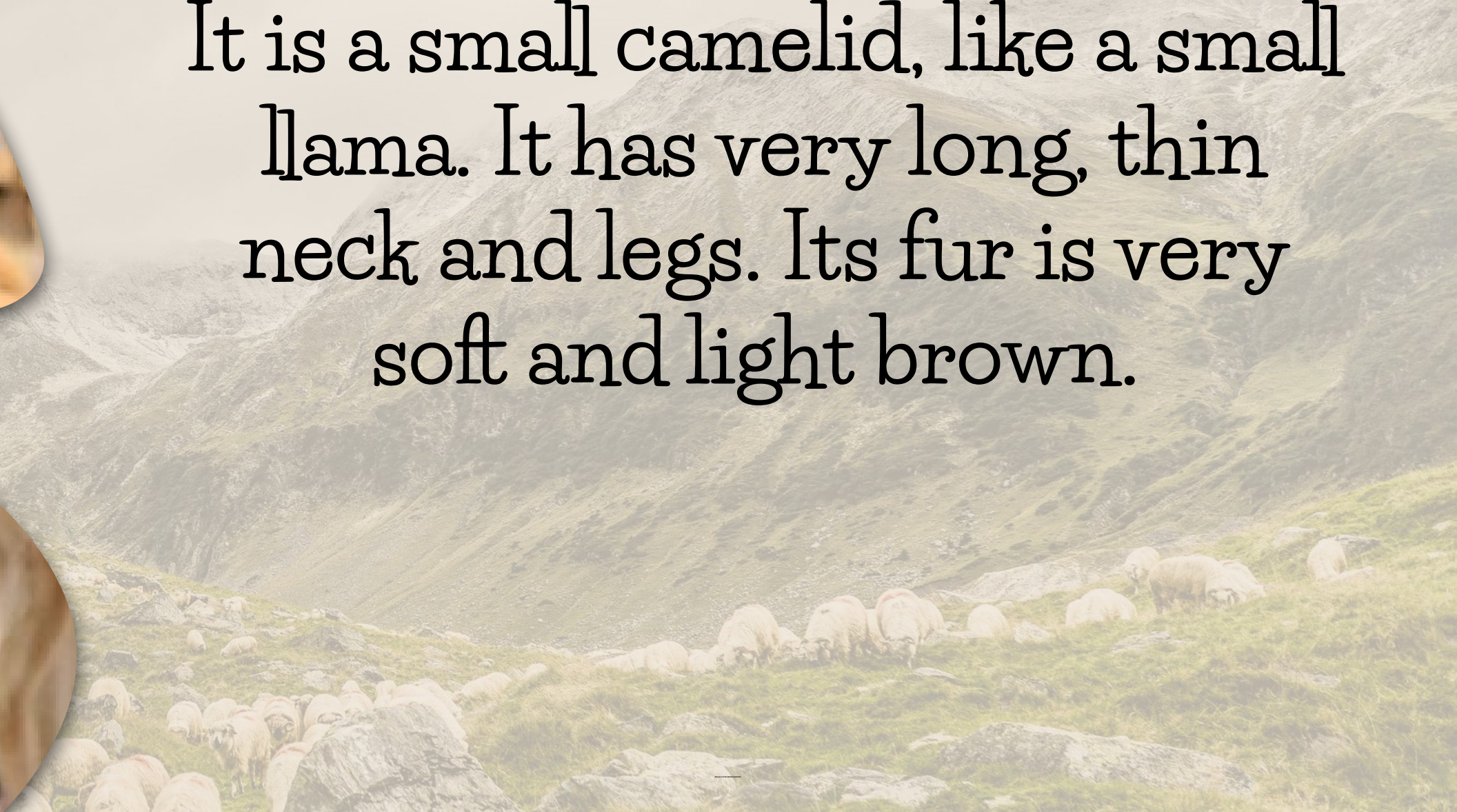
Where does it live?

The vicuña lives in the Andes Mountains in South America. It lives in the Puna region of Argentina, in places like Abra Pampa and Susques.



The vicuñas

It is a small camelid, like a small llama. It has very long, thin neck and legs. Its fur is very soft and light brown.



What does it eat?

FOOD

The vicuña is an herbivore. It eats short grasses and small plants found in the Puna.

GESTATION

A female vicuña is pregnant for about 11 months. It gives birth to only one baby (called a 'cria').

PREDATORS

The main natural predator is the puma. Humans are also a danger to them.
